



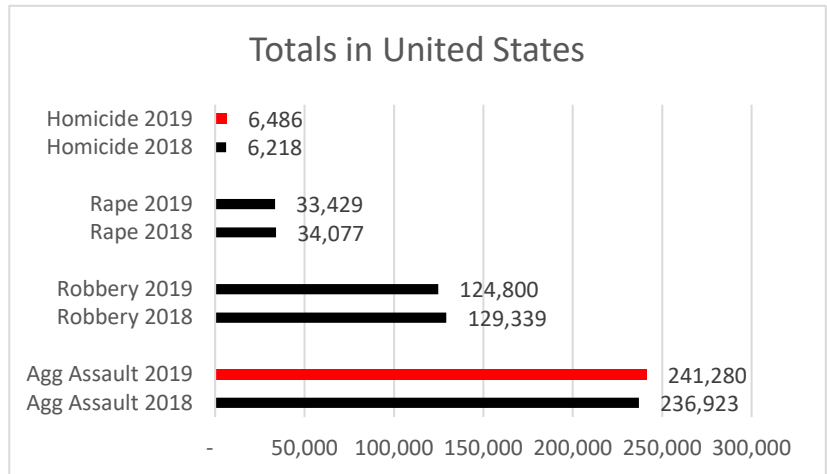

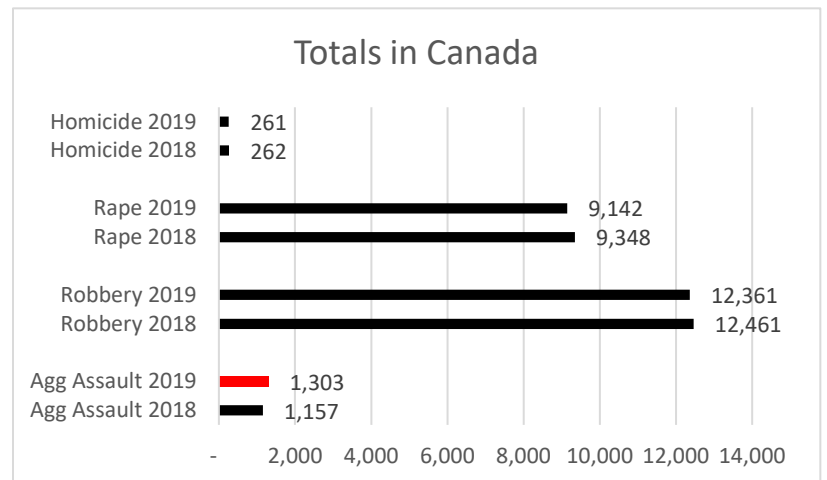

Update February 25, 2020
