Dear Chairman Grassley,

I write the express the Major Cities Chiefs Association's (MCCA) support for the Safeguarding America's First Responders Act of 2020. The MCCA membership is comprised of Chiefs and Sheriffs of the sixty-nine largest law enforcement agencies in the United States and the nine largest in Canada. Collectively, the MCCA represents over 79.9 million people with a workforce of 251,082 officers and non-sworn personnel.

Local law enforcement has continued to ensure the safety of our communities throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, oftentimes putting themselves at significant risk of infection. There have already been thousands of COVID-19 infections among law enforcement and close to 100 deaths. It's an unfortunate inevitability that those numbers will continue to rise. The presumption created by the *Safeguarding America's First Responders Act* will ensure law enforcement personnel who succumb to COVID-19 are eligible for benefits under the Public Safety Officers Benefit Program. It is only right that these brave men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice receive the benefits they are entitled to without unnecessary delays or complications.
