



Major Cities Chiefs Association Membership Application

The Major Cities Chiefs Association (MCCA) is a professional organization of police executives representing the largest cities in the United States and Canada. The mission of MCCA is to provide a forum for police executives from large population centers to address the challenges and issues of policing, to influence national and international policy that affects police services, to enhance the development of current and future police leaders, and to encourage and sponsor research that advances this mission.

Member Agency Qualifications

A law enforcement agency of a major city or major metropolitan area.

- A major city is defined as the largest city in the United States or Canada based on population as determined by the latest annual census.
- A major metropolitan area is defined as those with a residential population of at least 1.5 million and is comprised of at least 1,000 sworn law enforcement officers. The member applicant must have a residential population of at least 1.5 million and a minimum of 1,000 sworn law enforcement officers.

Membership Dues

Annual dues are currently established at \$7,500 per agency. The dues are used to help defray expenses incurred to maintain the purposes of the Association. Each member receives complimentary registration to 3 MCCA meetings a year. If the CEO departs the agency, MCCA membership automatically transfers to the new CEO.

Application Process

- All applicants regardless of agency qualifications must submit their application with the required supporting documents by 1 August to be considered for membership.
- Application to be received by the Executive Director and reviewed by the executive board.
- If approved, application will be presented to the membership for their vote during the annual meeting. A majority vote of those in attendance is required for approval.
- Applicants will be promptly notified of the membership decision.
- Approved membership in the Association will become effective on 1 January of the following year.
